Project Description

The Research Training Group is a postgraduate excellence programme and vibrant interdisciplinary research community in Passau, whose members investigate the implications of digital platform ecosystems for value-creation as well as overarching socio-economic and regulatory developments.

Within this program, Sarah ben Messaoud and Nikolai Sachs study how platforms can optimize their design to influence user behavior effectively. For instance, they study how reputation badges affect the performance of platform participants, both complementors and users. Furthermore, they investigate how the option to represent oneself as a 3D avatar on a platform influences trust between participants, particularly in the context of virtual reality platforms (e.g., the Metaverse), which are anticipated to shape the future of online interactions.
