Job description

The student will support Dr. Chayanin Wipusanawan in the Research Area A.1 of the research training group. The work involves supporting research activities on topics related to economic behaviour and regulations in the digital markets, primarily using the tools of microeconomic theory (game theoretical models). Tasks include, but are not limited to,

- Researching the supporting information on relevant topics, and the academic literature in economics, information systems, business, law, or related fields
- Preparing supporting materials such as graphics and slides
- · Occasionally, other organizational activities as requested
